AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI CAVALIERS (5-5-1, 2-1 CSAC)

Cabrini scored its first back to back wins of the season last week, with wins over Cairn and Gwynedd Mercy. The victories improved the club to 5-5-1 overall and 21 in the CSAC. Senior **Bobby Kane** scored twice, while classmate **AJ Bishop** paired a goal and two assists to lead Cabrini to a 7-0 win over Cairn. Kane added a 70th minute tally in the Cavaliers' 1-0 victory at Gwynedd Mercy. Cabrini will visit Neumann on Tuesday before hosting Clarks Summit on Saturday.

CAIRN HIGHLANDERS (4-8-1, 0-3 CSAC)

This past week the Highlanders dropped a pair of CSAC matches, falling to Cabrini during the week 7-0 and dropping a 2-1 double-overtime contest against Keystone over the weekend. The Highlanders played even with Cabrini for the first 30 minutes, but two goals in the final 15 minutes of the first-half gave the Cavaliers the momentum and they scored five second-half games en route to the big victory. Against Keystone the Highlanders and Giants played scoreless into the second-half before a goal by **Brendan Keller** in the 50th minute gave Cairn the lead. Keystone found an equalizer in the 63rd minute before the game headed to overtime. Cairn had the better of chances in the first overtime but couldn't find the back of the net. Three minutes into the second-overtime Keystone found the game winner and defeated Cairn 2-1.

CENTENARY CYCLONES (7-4, 3-0 CSAC)

The Cyclones went 2-0 last week including a CSAC win against Rosemont to remain unbeaten in conference play. Junior **Richy Castro** totaled seven points and netted the game-winning goal against Kings (Pa.). Centenary have a pair of road CSAC matches this week against Marywood and Neumann.

CLARKS SUMMIT DEFENDERS (4-8, 0-3 CSAC)

Heartbreak headlined CSU's week as they lost in double overtime with just a few seconds left on the clock to Immaculata University. The 1-0 loss was the second in a row for the Defenders. Saturday's loss in front of the homecoming crowd was the team's third CSAC setback of the season. The Defenders will take on Keystone College Tuesday, looking to avenge their 2015 overtime loss and then will travel to Cabrini University on Saturday.

GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (6-7, 2-1 CSAC)

The Gwynedd Mercy University Men's Soccer team suffered a 1-0 setback Saturday afternoon to Cabrini University in a CSAC match-up giving the Griffins their first CSAC defeat. **Tyler Blair** recorded five saves in the 2nd half for the Griffins with **Ryan Oyola** making two stops in the 1st. The Griffins suffered a 3-2 setback to Delaware Valley University on Tuesday afternoon in the Griffins final regular season non-conference match-up. **Chris Black** connected on a penalty shot while **Danny Saba** scored on a cross from brother **Matt Saba** to cut the lead to 3-2. GMercyU played a trio of goalies on the day, with **Kace Peters** and Blair each recording a save.

IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (7-4-1, 2-1 CSAC)

Immaculata went 2-0 this past week as it wrapped up non-conference play with a 1-0 win against Stockton and defeated Clarks Summit 1-0 in double overtime. **Nick Boule** scored both goals during the week for the Mighty Macs, while goalkeeper **Joe Lubonski** made 11 saves on his way to a clean sheet for the week. Boule scored in the fifth minute against the Osprey and on the 110th minute against the Defenders.

AROUND THE CSAC

KEYSTONE GIANTS (6-3-1, 3-0 CSAC)

Keystone continued its best start in conference play since joining the season with a hard-fought, 2-1 double overtime win a Cairn on Saturday. **Abreham Kittel** scored the game-winning goal in the 103rd minute while **Ibrahim Tounkara** scored the second half equalizer before assisting on Kittel's overtime tally. **Malcom Moreira** made five saves to pick up his fourth win of the season for the Giants, who will visit Clarks Summit on Tuesday before hosting Rosemont on Saturday.

MARYWOOD PACERS (4-6, 2-1 CSAC)

Marywood beat Neumann on its home turf for the first time in program history in a 1-0 shutout win. **Patrick Brogan** made nine saves to preserve a shutout. **Zach Oster** scored the lone goal of the game in the 76th minute to lift the Pacers. It was also Coach **Dawson Driscoll's** 99th career victory. **Jimmy Fields** netted the assist. Marywood will host CSAC leading Centenary Tuesday.

NEUMANN KNIGHTS (3-9, 1-2 CSAC)

Neumann went 0-2 on the week, dropping a non-conference match to Johns Hopkins University on Wednesday and a CSAC game to Marywood on Saturday. Despite doubling the Pacers in shots 18-9, the Knights could not find the back of the net in the 1-0 loss. **Jake McDevitt** led the team with six shots in the loss, while keeper **Shane Smith** made two saves. Neumann will host Cabrini and Centenary this week as they look to get back into the race for the CSAC playoffs.

ROSEMONT RAVENS (2-8-2, 0-3 CSAC)

The Ravens split a pair of games this week, defeating Bryn Athyn, 5-2 on the road, and getting nipped back at home by the Centenary Cyclones in a CSAC contest. In the win at Bryn Athyn, freshman midfielder **Sean Borden** turned around a 1-0 deficit, scoring five straight goals in the second half to propel the Ravens to the 5-2 win. Borden added his 6th goal of the week in the game against Centenary, to spark a Rosemont comeback attempt. This week the Ravens will hit the road, traveling to Immaculata on Tuesday and Keystone on Saturday.
