Tralie scored a pair of goals last week to help Cabrini extend its win streak to six matches. The junior's 21st minute goal gave Cabrini an early lead in a 2-1 win at Keystone, while her 52nd minute goal at Immaculata proved to be the game-winner.

PAYTON EMERICK, Cairn, So., GK

Emerick made her first career start in goal on Saturday and shut out Keystone, helping the Highlanders to the 1-0 victory. Emerick made 12 saves in the effort, including a number of acrobatic saves throughout the contest.

KAILEY HOPKINS, Gwynedd Mercy, So., GK

Hopkins made eight saves to help lead Gwynedd Mercy to a 3-0 CSAC win at Cedar Crest on Saturday. She would tie a career-high with 13 saves against Marywood on Tuesday earlier in the week in a 2-1 setback.

MCKENZIE DAILEY, Marywood, So., D

Dailey led the Pacers to a 2-0 week with stellar play at center back and even registered an assist in a 3-0 win over Notre Dame. In a 2-1 win over Gwynedd Mercy, Dailey led a Pacers' defense that allowed just three shots (one on goal). Against the Gators, Marywood allowed just six shots (three on goal) and picked up a shutout.

AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI CAVALIERS (6-5-0, 5-0-0)

Cabrini extended its win streak to six matches with a pair of 2-1 road wins last week. Junior **Taylor Tralie** and freshman **Katelyn Gilinger** scored in the Cavaliers' win at Keystone, while freshman **Alex Garces** and **Tralie** marked the scoring column in a victory at Immaculata. Junior **Gabby LeGendre** notched nine saves to secure the wins. Cabrini will return to Edith Robb Dixon Field this week, as it hosts Clarks Summit on Wednesday and Marywood on Saturday for the team's annual breast cancer awareness match.

CEDAR CREST FALCONS (5-5-1, 1-3-1)

The Falcons fell in their two games this week. They lost the first game to Rosemont College, 2-1 with a goal by freshman forward **Kelsey Kehm**. They dropped the second game of the week to Gwynedd Mercy 3-0. The next match for Cedar Crest is on Wednesday, October 12 at Neumann.

CLARKS SUMMIT DEFENDERS (1-11-0, 0-6-0)

The Lady Defenders struggled through a tough week, losing 8-0 and 8-1 to Centenary University and Neumann University. **Makenzi Kaiser's** unselfish pass to **Heidi Depue** led to the team's goal in front of the homecoming crowd. A long week lies ahead for the team, as they take on Cabrini University on Wednesday, host PSU Hazleton on Friday and wrap things up hitting the road again to battle Notre Dame (MD) University on Saturday.

IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (4-8-0, 4-2-0)

The Mighty Macs won their third consecutive CSAC game earlier in the week as they topped Notre Dame, 2-1, on Tuesday. **Carly Mirarchi** put the Macs up 1-0, and after the Gators tied it in the second half, **Carrie Quigley** provided the game-winner to put the Macs at 4-1 in the conference. On Saturday, the Macs played Cabrini close the entire game, but ended up falling 2-1. The Cavaliers took a 2-0 lead, but the Macs fought back with a goal by **Courtney Stinger** late in the game. IU ran out of time in the one-goal defeat. The Macs will host Centenary on Wednesday before travelling to Rosemont on Saturday.

CAIRN HIGHLANDERS (4-6-0, 1-4-0)

The Highlanders suffered a 6-3 loss in the middle of the week against Neumann but earned a hard-fought 1-0 shutout victory of Keystone over the weekend for their first CSAC victory of the season. **Meghan Wilson** scored twice for the Highlanders this week and assisted on another goal. She scored the lone goal in the 1-0 victory over Keystone and is the first CSAC player to 20 points this season. **Wilson** has scored in six of the eight games she has played in this season. Between the pipes the Highlanders saw a pair of new faces in **Elizabeth Selle** and **Payton Emerick**. **Emerick** played the second-half against Neumann and the full game against Keystone and was stellar against the Giants. In her first career start in goal, **Emerick** made 12 saves and kept a clean sheet for the 1-0 victory.

CENTENARY CYCLONES (5-5-0, 4-2-0)

The Cyclones posted a pair of CSAC victories last week with wins against Clarks Summit and Rosemont. Sophomore **Amanda Benoit** and freshman **Chloe Christopher** each netted eight points in the two wins. Centenary faces a pair of CSAC opponents on the road this week as they travel to Immaculata and Neumann.

GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (5-4-2, 3-2-0)

Lauren Melino had a goal and an assist while goalie **Kailey Hopkins** made eight saves to help lead Gwynedd Mercy to a 3-0 CSAC win at Cedar Crest on Saturday. **Melino** scored her first collegiate goal off a corner kick from **Grace Macnamara**. **Meghan Petroski** would make it 2-0 on a **Madeline Swartley** assist. The Griffins would tack on an insurance score late in the contest when **Melino** set up **Samantha Brown** to account for the scoring. GMercyU suffered a deflating 2-1 defeat on the road at Marywood Tuesday afternoon in CSAC action. Less than a minute into the action when **Anna Numerato** scored from inside the eighteen on an assist from **Petroski**. Marywood would respond in the second half with a pair of goals to take a 2-1 lead. **Hopkins** would tie a career-high with 13 saves.

KEYSTONE GIANTS (5-5-1, 2-3-1)

Keystone dropped a pair of one-goal conference games last week, suffering a 2-1 setback to Cabrini on Tuesday before being dealt a 1-0 loss at Cairn on Saturday. **Hannah Richner** scored the Giants' goal against the Cavaliers off an assist from **Kristy Hansen**. **Rebekah Shepherd** made 10 saves on the week while **Sarah Heintz** turned aside eight shots in goal. Keystone hosts Marywood on Wednesday and Gwynedd Mercy on Saturday in a pair of important CSAC games this week.

AROUND THE CSAC

MARYWOOD PACERS (6-4-1, 6-0-0)

Marywood remained unbeaten in the CSAC (6-0) with a 2-0 week as the Pacers defeated Gwynedd Mercy 2-1 and Notre Dame of Maryland 3-0. Against the Griffins, Marywood trailed 1-0 at the half despite a 16-1 advantage in shots but the Pacers would get second half goals from **Jackie Vonlitter** and **Ashley Kruchinsky** to survive the scare. Against Notre Dame, **Kruchinsky**, **Julie Youngman** and **Brianna Untener** would score and Marywood would get assists from three others. The Pacers travel to Keystone Wednesday and Cabrini Saturday.

NEUMANN KNIGHTS (7-5-0, 4-2-0)

Neumann went 2-0 in conference action during the week with a 6-3 win over Cairn on Tuesday and an 8-1 victory over Clarks Summit on Saturday. The Knights received balanced scoring in both games this week as five different players scored goals versus Cairn and eight different players found the back of the net against Clarks Summit. **Jamie King** led the team with 3 goals on the week, while keeper **Anna Attardi** picked up both wins in net. Neumann will host Cedar Crest and Centenary this coming week.

NOTRE DAME GATORS (2-8-0, 1-5-0)

The Gators fell 2-1 to Immaculata on Tuesday and 3-0 to Marywood on Saturday. In the loss to the Mighty Macs, sophomore **Meghan Conner's** 20-yard lob pass from the left side found classmate **Jessie Lindenkohl** on the break for her third goal on the year. Sophomore **Lily Gordon** and freshman **Loren Pardoe** split time in net, combining for 11 saves. Against the Pacers, **Pardoe** kept the Gators afloat with 13 saves, while **Conner** recorded a pair of shots on goal. The club visits Gwynedd Mercy on Wednesday and hosts Clarks Summit on Saturday.

ROSEMONT RAVENS (2-10-0, 1-11-0)

The Ravens split two games this week. On Tuesday, an early goal from **Melissa Lynch**, and a late game-winning goal from **Victoria Kasper** boosted Rosemont to a 2-1 victory at Cedar Crest on Tuesday. On Saturday, the Ravens suffered a 5-1 defeat at Centenary. **Cheyenne Tumolo's** second goal of the season was the score for the Ravens. This week, the team continues with two more CSAC contests. On Wednesday the team will travel to Cairn, followed by a game on Saturday back home against Immaculata.
