AROUND THE CSAC

CABRINI CAVALIERS (6-8, 4-2 CSAC)

Cabrini split a pair of games last week, moving to 6-8 overall and 4-2 in the conference. Senior **Jackie Neary** scored two goals, while classmate **Brittany Smith** added two assists to lead the Cavaliers to a 3-1 win over Immaculata on Wednesday. The Blue and White made the trip to Keystone on Saturday, as returned with a disappointing 2-1 loss despite outshooting the Giants 17-1 in the first half. The Cavaliers will close CSAC play on Wednesday, as they host Notre Dame of MD before hosting Alvernia in Saturday's regular season finale.

CEDAR CREST FALCONS (10-5, 3-3 CSAC)

The Falcons went 2-0 on the week with two shutouts. The team defeated Keystone 1-0 with a goal from freshman midfielder **Annalise Unger** while six Falcons scored in the teams 8-0 win over Notre Dame of Maryland. The next game for the Falcons is on Wednesday, October 25 against Neumann.

GWYNEDD MERCY GRIFFINS (13-3, 6-0 CSAC)

The GMercyU Field Hockey team scored their fourth-straight shutout victory and fifth overall with a 7-0 win over visiting Marywood on Saturday. Four different Griffins scored on the evening highlighted by Kaitlyn Lutz and her three-goal performance. The win also puts Gwynedd as the top seed in the upcoming CSAC Tournament. Melissa Russo added a pair of scores and both Abigail Gabriel and Allison Campbell added helpers. Abi Kennedy recorded one save to record her third clean sheet of the season. The Griffins earned a 6-0 victory over Neumann on Tuesday. Lutz scored a pair of first half goals to spark the GMercyU offense. Brianna O'Connell added a pair of goals in the second half while Russo and Jamie McCarney added scores in the second stanza as well.

IMMACULATA MIGHTY MACS (6-11, 4-2 CSAC)

Immaculata inched closer to a berth in the CSAC Tournament going 1-1 in league play. Immaculata fell to Cabrini, 3-1, but started its three-game home stand to end the regular season with a 4-3 win against Neumann. Senior **Megan Donegan** scored with just over five minutes remaining in regulation to break a 3-3 tie and propel the Mighty Macs to the victory. Donegan led IU with four points (1 goal, 2 assists) for the week. This would mark the first time since the 2014 season IU has reached the postseason, and its four CSAC wins is the most since the 2013 campaign. Immaculata finishes the regular season hosting Gwynedd Mercy and DeSales.

KEYSTONE GIANTS (6-9, 3-3 CSAC)

Keystone went 1-1 in a pair of CSAC games last week, dropping a 1- 0 decision to Cedar Crest on Wednesday before topping Cabrini 2-1 on Saturday. Savanna Robinson had a goal and an assist while Kayla Bain also scored in the win over the Cavaliers. Emily Hawkins made 18 saves on the week and Daphne Leenas added a pair of defensive saves. Keystone needs a win in Wednesday's regular season finale and some help to qualify for the CSAC playoffs for the third straight year.

MARYWOOD PACERS (4-11, 3-3 CSAC)

Marywood dropped their only contest of the week in a tough 7-0 lost to league-leading Gwynedd Mercy. Despite the loss, the Pacers' playoff hopes remain alive and a win over Keystone mid-week can keep them in the hunt for a playoff spot. Marywood will also travel to Misericordia to close the regular season.
